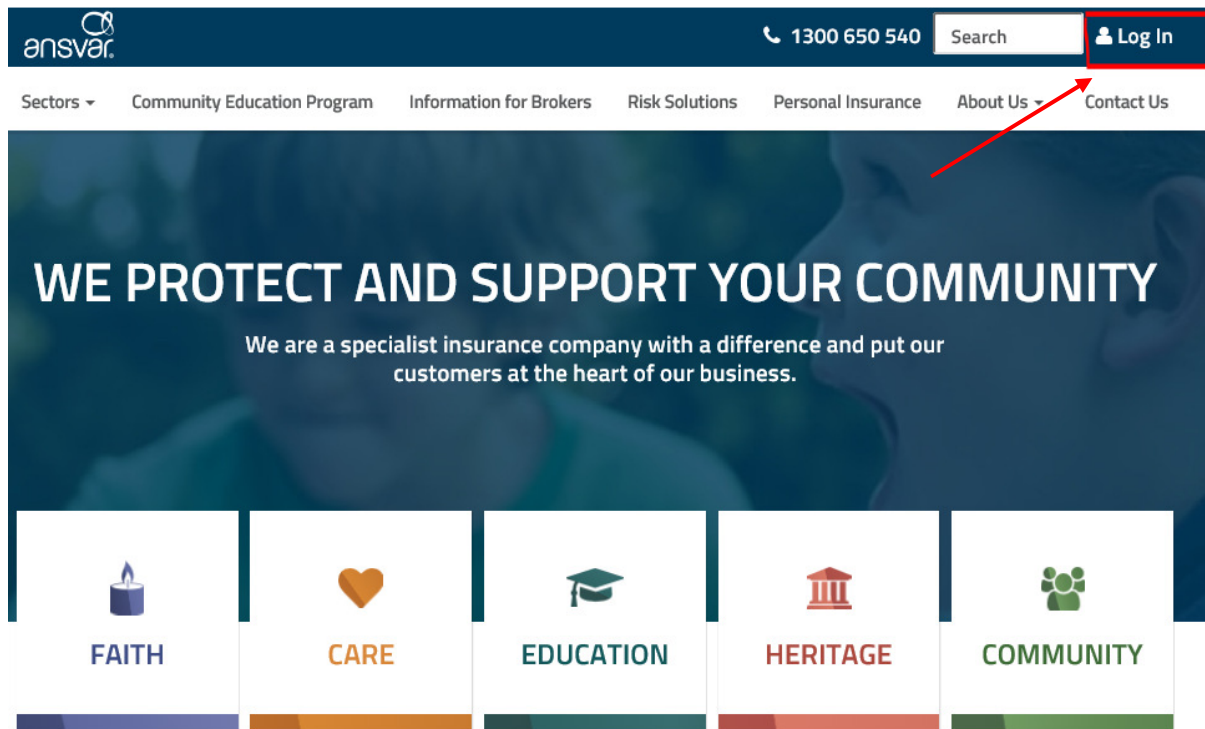


1. Accessing Broker Portal

To access the Broker Portal, go to Ansvar website – www.ansvar.com.au


- Click “Log In”



2. Logging into Broker Portal


The username is your email address and password is system generated, that you would have received via email.

3. Searching for a policy

You can search for a policy by any of the following factors

You can search by entering multiple fields. The more data you put in the more accurate your search will be.

Please note: you cannot solely use the postcode field as it will return excessive data – please only use this field in conjunction with another.

4. Policy Search Results

The search results will bring back the policy cards as below.

By clicking 'expand all', you will be able to see the following additional data:

- Original Inception Date
- Current Inception Date
- Coverage Type



5. Claim Notification

On the claim notification page, you will be prompted to enter the following:

- Description of Loss
- Date of Loss
- Date Reported – defaults to the date you are completing the form
- Functionality to attach multiple files (Optional) – 18 MB limit

Once completed, click “submit”
